### Health Care Plans

If you have been provided with health care documentation for your child, please ensure it is completed and returned to the Office **as soon as possible.**

### Medication at school

#### Prescribed medication

If your child requires prescribed medication, for example **antibiotics**, to be administered during school hours please contact the school office for a 'Request for administering prescribed medication to the student' form.

It is a requirement of the Department of Education and Communities that if your child requires medication prescribed by a doctor it is provided with a valid expiry date. The medication must be sent to school in the original packaging and will only be administered if correct paperwork has been completed and the medication has your child's name printed on the prescription label.

#### Over the counter medication

If your child requires over the counter medication, for example **Panadol**, to be administered during school hours please also contact the school office for a 'Request for administering prescribed medication to the student' form.

### Absences

You can notify the school of your child's absences on the Skoolbag app. In the Skoolbag app in the **eForms** tab you can select **Absentee Note** and complete the form that is then sent directly to the school so that we can update your child's records.

You can also use the **eForm** set up in **CareMonkey**.

Alternatively notes and/or doctor's certificates can be provided to the Office. Thank you for your cooperation.

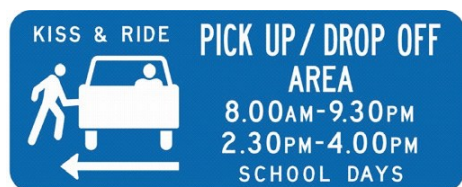

## Student Safety



It has been brought to our attention by the school crossing officer that several parents are not using these zones correctly. For your children's safety can all parents who use these zones familiarise themselves with the following rules. We have advised the police and Hurstville City Council who will be monitoring these zones and issuing fines if necessary.

The Kiss and Ride Zones in Pindari Avenue and Monterra Avenue are for your convenience and for your child's safety.

### Kiss and Ride rules:

- Kiss and Ride zones and 'No Parking' zones operate under the same conditions – you may stop to drop off or pick up children for a maximum of **2 minutes**
- Driver must remain in or within 3 metres of vehicle
- Zone applies only during hours of operation

**Minimum penalty \$165 and 2 demerit points**

#### For the Safety of Children in the Kiss and Ride Zone - Points to Remember

##### **Drivers do not leave your vehicle**

To assist with traffic flow in the Kiss and Ride Zone, drivers should remain in the car whilst children get in and out. To facilitate this, children should travel with bags in the car and not in the boot. If a driver must get out, they **MUST NOT** move more than 3 metres from their vehicle.

##### **Be timely**

If your child does not enter or exit the vehicle within **2 minutes** you are required to travel around the block and re-enter the zone at the end of the queue.

##### **Stay in sequence**

Please queue in an orderly manner. Drop/pick-up your child as close as you can to the top of the zone, allowing vehicles following you to enter the designated area.

##### **Child safety**

Please ensure children get in or out of the vehicle on the kerb side. The back seat is the safest seat for children to travel in, regardless of the make of vehicle. Ensure children have their restraints securely fastened before driving off

##### **No U Turns**

Do not do u-turns in busy school zones. They are dangerous and put children at risk.

**Hurstville Council Rangers, Parking Officers and the Police enforce these rules and issue penalties, so always use the zone correctly to avoid fines.**
